Tombola: history and traditions

In Italy tombola is a very common family game played at Christmas, and is similar to bingo, the English version so popular in the United Kingdom, Ireland and, under many forms all around the world. In Italy at Christmas Eve playing tombola is a must, with all the relatives united around grandparents and small children shouting when they win a prize (adults usually don't call a prize if there are children around, so they can let them win). Modern tombola cards are in plastic and have small plastic slots over the numbers that can be closed down when the number is called, but traditionally the numbers were covered by beans ("fagioli") or by pieces of orange peel, that you had to eat while playing.
